

Rules for transfer to new curricula

Training years	Rules
ST1-5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Educational Supervisor/ARCP panel will look at the evidence as usual provided from the NES system/old curriculum and undertake the ARCP. • The ARCP outcome will be issued and moved automatically into the new ePortfolio. • A PDF of the evidence the trainee has accumulated in the old ePortfolio will be uploaded into the new ePortfolio by 31 October. • Trainees progressing from ST5 to ST6 will progress to the new curriculum.
ST6-7 ATSMs All advanced trainees have to meet core as well as their advanced curricular requirements	<p>Core</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be one page on the new ePortfolio which will allow for sign-off of the 30 advanced competencies (dark pink boxes) from the 2013 Core Curriculum and include all other elements of the previous Supervisor’s Report. • Trainees will need to fulfil the requirements of the current Matrix in terms of numbers of WBA and ongoing competence OSATS, NOT the new Matrix. The amended WBA are substantially the same as the current WBA. • This will allow the advanced trainees to be signed off for the 2013 Core Curriculum on the new ePortfolio. • This can carry on for as long as necessary, but these doctors will also be given the option to transfer to the 2019 Core Curriculum if they wish to. <p>ATSMs</p> <p>SCENARIO A – For those trainees who have an ARCP between 20 May to 6 August 2019:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trainees undertaking but not completing ATSMs by 7 August 2019 will remain on the NES system until 7 August 2019. • For trainees with an ARCP between May to July the Educational Supervisor/ARCP panel will look at the evidence as usual provided from the NES system/old curriculum. • The ARCP outcome will be recorded in the old ePortfolio • Trainees will be transferred to the new ePortfolio between 7 August to 31 October 2019. • Either prior to or at the point of transferring there should be a discussion, based on the key skills and descriptors of the relevant new ATSMs, as to what the trainee has left to complete to meet the requirements of the new ATSM curriculum. • The ATSM Educational Supervisor and trainee should make a record of this discussion on the ePortfolio. • A PDF of the evidence the trainee has accumulated in the old ePortfolio will be uploaded to the new ePortfolio for reference.

	<p>SCENARIO B - For those trainees who have an ARCP between 7 August to 31 October 2019:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trainees undertaking but not completing ATSMs by 7 August 2019 will remain on the NES system until 7 August 2019. • For trainees with and ARCP between August and October the Educational Supervisor/ARCP panel will look at the evidence as usual provided from the NES system/old curriculum. • There should be a discussion, based on the key skills and descriptors of the relevant new ATSMs, as to what the trainee has left to complete to meet the requirements of the new curriculum. • The ARCP outcome and a record of the discussion on the new ATSMs will need to be recorded in the old ePortfolio • Trainees will be transferred to the new ePortfolio between 7 August to 31 October 2019 immediately after their ARCP. • A PDF of the evidence the trainee has accumulated in the old ePortfolio will be uploaded to the new ePortfolio for reference.
<p>ST6-7 Subspecialty All subspecialty trainees have to meet core as well as their advanced curricular requirements</p>	<p>Core</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SST Trainees should have completed the core curriculum competencies before entering SST. If they have not, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ There will be one page on the new ePortfolio which will allow for sign-off of the 30 advanced competencies (dark pink boxes) from the 2013 Core Curriculum and include all other elements of the previous Supervisor’s Report. ○ This will allow the advanced trainees to be signed off for the 2013 Core Curriculum on the new ePortfolio. ○ These doctors will use the amended WBA to fulfil the old “matrix” i.e. get the number they need of everything. The amended WBA are substantially the same as the current WBA. <p>Subspecialty</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trainees will not be able to transfer to the new curricula until 31 October. <p>SCENARIO A - For those trainees who are having an SST assessment in early October and who are likely to complete their SST training by 31 October:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Educational Supervisor/subspecialty assessment panel will look at the evidence provided from the NES system/old curriculum. ○ The SST assessment outcome will be recorded in the old ePortfolio. ○ The PDF of the evidence the trainee has accumulated in the old ePortfolio will be uploaded into the new ePortfolio and the trainee issued with the new ePortfolio account by 31 October. <p>SCENARIO B - For those trainees who are having an assessment in early October and who are not likely to complete their SST training by 31 October:</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The SST assessors will undertake the normal assessment and also report on the trainee’s progress against the new SST CiPs. ○ The Subspecialty Training Programme Supervisor/subspecialty assessment panel will look at the evidence as usual provided from the NES system/old curriculum, including the subspecialty assessors’ report. ○ There should be a discussion, based on the key skills and descriptors of the new SST CIPs, as to what the trainee has left to complete to meet the requirements of the new SST curriculum. ○ The subspecialty assessment panel and a record of the discussion on the new CIPs will be need to be recorded in the old ePortfolio. ○ The trainee can continue to acquire evidence in the old ePortfolio. ○ A PDF of the evidence the trainee has accumulated in the old ePortfolio will be uploaded into the new ePortfolio by 31 October and the trainee issued with the new ePortfolio account. <p>SCENARIO C - For those trainees who are not having an assessment in early October and who are likely to complete their SST training by 31 October:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Subspecialty Training Programme Supervisor will look at the evidence as usual provided from the NES system/old curriculum. ○ A record of the discussion on the new CIPs will need to be recorded in the old ePortfolio. ○ The trainee can continue to acquire evidence in the old ePortfolio. ○ A PDF of the evidence the trainee has accumulated in the old ePortfolio will be uploaded into the new ePortfolio by 31 October and the trainee issued with the new ePortfolio account. <p>SCENARIO D - For those trainees who are not having an assessment in early October and who are not likely to complete their training by 31 October:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Subspecialty Training Programme Supervisor will look at the evidence as usual provided from the NES system/old curriculum. ○ There should be a discussion with the STPS, based on the key skills and descriptors of the new CIPs, as to what the trainee has left to complete to meet the requirements of the new curriculum. ○ A record of the discussion on the new CIPs will need to be recorded in the old ePortfolio. ○ The trainee can continue to acquire evidence in the old ePortfolio. ○ A PDF of the evidence the trainee has accumulated in the old ePortfolio will be uploaded into the new ePortfolio by 31 October and the trainee issued with the new ePortfolio account.
<p>LTFT, out of programme, mat leave etc – ST1-7</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Detailed guidance will be produced on how to conduct the first ARCPs for these trainees after they have transferred, as the Educational Supervisor/ARCP panel will need to look at the evidence on the PDF provided from the NES system/old curriculum, along with whatever evidence the

	trainee has accumulated in the interim on the new system, in order to work out an outcome.
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
