- Abstracts must follow the structured format outlined using the abstract template below and submitted along with this form. (If you are submitting multiple abstracts, please complete one form per abstract). Case studies can be submitted on this form using your own format; rules below still apply
- All abstracts will be considered for the oral presentation in the first instance. Those not selected for oral presentation will automatically be considered for poster presentation.
- Abstracts will be refereed in the absence of names and addresses of authors.
- The subject or content should relate to any field in Obstetrics and Gynaecology (scientific abstracts will also be accepted if related to Obstetrics and Gynaecology)
- Abstracts must be typewritten in English.
- Abstracts must not exceed one side of A4 in length (including diagrams and figures) using single-spacing, maximum 300 words.
- Tables may be included (Text in tables are included in the maximum words allowed).
- The font size used should not be smaller than 11 points.
- Certificate will be given the main presenting author only
- **Please note that only authors named on the abstract are permitted to present the poster**
- Presenting author and co-authors must register to attend
