<b>MRCOG Part 1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completed Part 1 Eligibility</li> <li>• 6 attempts allowed</li> </ul> <p><i>Candidates wishing to attempt the exam again after 6 previous fails must have supporting documentation from their Head of School (or equivalent) outlining the exceptional reasons for permitting a further attempt at the exam</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completed Part 1 Eligibility</li> <li>• No limit of attempts</li> </ul>
<b>MRCOG Part 2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passed Part 1</li> <li>• 6 attempts allowed</li> </ul> <p><i>Candidates wishing to attempt the exam again after 6 previous fails must have supporting documentation from their Head of School (or equivalent) outlining the exceptional reasons for permitting a further attempt at the exam</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If passed Part 1 after March 2013, have 7 years to first attempt Part 2 or pro rata to a max of 10 years if in less than full time training</li> <li>• If passed the Part 1 in/before March 2013, have 10 years to first attempt Part 2</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passed Part 1</li> <li>• No limit of attempts</li> <li>• Need to attempt this exam within 10 years of passing Part 1</li> </ul>
<b>MRCOG Part 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passed Part 2</li> <li>• Completed Assessment of Training (AOT) – supporting documents not required</li> <li>• 4 attempts allowed. If not succeeded will need to re-sit Part 2</li> <li>• Need to attempt this exam within 7 years (pro rata) of passing Part 2</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passed Part 2</li> <li>• Completed Assessment of Training (AOT) – supporting documents required</li> <li>• 4 attempts allowed. If not succeeded will need to re-sit Part 2</li> <li>• Need to attempt this exam within 7 years (pro rata) of passing Part 2</li> </ul>
