



Liaison Group (LG) Role Description for Committee Membership

RCOG Liaison Groups (LGs) are made up of international College members resident in the UK, or College members with a strong interest in a specific country. Each group is known as the RCOG (country) Liaison Group. They form an important link with the respective International Representative Committee (IRC) where one exists.

The RCOG advocates an open and transparent appointment process. Committee positions will be managed by LGs with the initial notification of appointments for committee positions issued by the College and then managed locally from that point on by the LG Chair. The LG Chair and committee members will work closely with their respective IRC (where one exists) to provide support for IRC activities outlined in the collaboration frameworks.

Active Fellows and Members who are up to date with their fees, in active practice, and can demonstrate a clear and defined connection with the country are eligible to apply. Honorary Fellows, Retired Fellows or Members, Trainees, Associates or non-members of the RCOG are not eligible to apply.

Roles and responsibilities

- Work collaboratively with the LG Chair and committee members to support the activity of the LG in line with the terms of reference
- To help grow RCOG membership and assist in the promotion of Associate status
- To promote education and training of doctors working in the field of obstetrics and gynaecology
- To ensure that LG activities are carried out in line with relevant College policies and UK laws and regulations
- Uphold the RCOG values of High Standards; Inclusiveness; Innovation; Trust and Openness
- To observe the RCOG Code of Conduct which provides clear expectations on how members, trainees, professionals and other representatives of the RCOG ('the College') conduct themselves <https://www.rcog.org.uk/about-us/policies/code-of-conduct/>

- A Fellow or Member of the RCOG
- To be up to date with membership subscription fees
- Registered with a licence to practice with the General Medical Council
- In active clinical practice



Eligibility

- Clear and defined connection with the country
- Individuals cannot serve on the committee more than twice
